Bachelor of Science (General)

Consult your major advisor while completing this plan. Students must file this plan with their advisor prior to preregistration in their fifth semester. An approved final plan of study must be filed with the Registrar during the first four weeks of classes of the semester in which the student expects to be graduated. Once it is filed with the registrar, changes in the plan may be made only with the consent of the major advisor.

THE MAJOR GROUP: (Major courses must be numbered 2000 or above).

At least 36 credits in Physics. Students must have a grade point average of 2.0 or better in the 36 credits constituting the major group. Only quality points and credits earned at the University of Connecticut may be used to meet this requirement, save where the dean of the college grants exception.
